Dead soldier linked to Kingsdown siege walks in local park

Fremantle Square, Kingsdown (near the Hillgrove Porter Stores) is the site of a civil war fort. Called Prior Hill Fort, it came under **fierce attack** during the sieges of Bristol - by Prince Rupert and the Royalists in 1643, when they captured the city,

and by Cromwell and Fairfax in 1645. Cromwell was **attacking** Prince Rupert at the fort, and mustered his New Model Army at Stapleton prior to the assault.

A roundhead **ghost** still walks in the Stapleton woods. It approaches

walkers as if to speak, but then passes straight through them. A recent eyewitness said: "I was walking my dog and I heard a rustling behind me. When I turned around, there was **nothing there.**"
